Sled Dog Class:

1. Entry must be an AKC or CKC registered Siberian Husky (entry must be eligible under Chapter 11, Section 1 of the AKC Rules applying to Registration and Dog Shows)
2. There will be a class for dogs and bitches. Winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in the regular class.
3. If entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid, no additional entry fee will be required. If not, the entry fee for a regular class will be required.
4. During the previous racing season (April 1, 2002 through March 31, 2003) each entry MUST have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of five (5) miles per heat or competition or completed a total of seventy (70) miles in competition.
5. Races MUST have been under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results.
6. A list of races in which the dog competed must be sent to the Show Secretary when entries are made. Proof of competition must be made available at ringside if challenged.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of his Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Entry Fee \$23.00 if the Stud Dog is NOT entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid. If already entered the fee for the unit is \$14.00. Get MUST be individually entered in one of the classes of this show for which it is eligible. Each unit of 3 (Stud Dog and 2 Get) shall be an entity unto itself. Stud Dog or his Get may not be part of another unit.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Non-Regular Obedience Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Veteran Obedience: The Veteran Obedience Class shall be for dogs that have an Obedience Title and are seven (7) or more years old prior to the closing of entries. An entry fee of \$23 shall be charged if not entered in another class. As an additional entry, the fee is \$14.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
