ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

From the Northeast - Interstate 69.

Interstate 69 South. Exit 10 (State Rd. 238). Turn Right (SR238 towards Noblesville). Continue on SR-238 until you reach State Rd. 37. Turn right onto SR37. At second automatic signal turn left (Pleasant Street). Turn left on Clover Street. Hamilton County 4-H Fairgrounds is on the right.

From all other Directions - Interstate 465.

Take I-465 (interstate loop around Indianapolis) to I-69 North. At Exit 5 Follow State Road 37 towards Noblesville. Continue on SR37 until you reach Pleasant Street. Turn Left on Pleasant Street. Turn Left on Clover Street. Hamilton County 4-H Fairgrounds is on the right.
